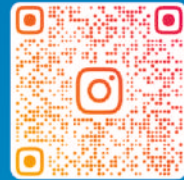

A brief history of the Kyrgyz National University named after Jusup Balasagyn

On March 30, 1925 at the organizational Congress of the Council of the Kara-Kirghiz Autonomous Region the issue of establishing the Kara-Kyrgyz Institute of Education was discussed. After preparatory work, in October 1925 the Kyrgyz Institute of Education was founded in Pishpek. In 1928 the Kyrgyz Institute of Education was transformed into the Central Pedagogical Institute. On May 31, 1930 the Council of People's Commissars of the Russian Soviet Federative Socialist Republic adopted a resolution on founding higher educational institution in the Kirghiz Autonomous Republic.

The Kirghiz State Pedagogical Institute named after M.V. Frunze was founded in 1932 and this date can be considered as the foundation date of the present KNU named after J. Balasagyn, whose origin starts from specialized educational institutions that were established in 1925, the 20th century, with the purpose of solving the issues of university teachers for the Kyrgyz Republic. On May 24, 1951 the Council of Ministers of the USSR adopted a resolution on founding the Kyrgyz State University in Frunze on the basis of the Kirghiz Pedagogical Institute named after M.V. Frunze. On December 11, 1972 the title "Kirghiz State University named after the 50th anniversary of the USSR" was awarded by the Resolution of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Kirghizia and the Council of Ministers of the Kirghiz SSR. Taking into account the successful work of the university in a rapidly changing world, as a well as its positive role in democratic reforms in the socio-political life of the country, on August 11, 1993 the Kyrgyz State National University named after the 50th anniversary of the USSR was transformed into the Kyrgyz State National University by a special decree of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic.

On May 11, 2002 the Kyrgyz State National University was given a status of "National" and renamed as the Kyrgyz National University named after J. Balasagyn by the Decree of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic.

International cooperation of KNU

International cooperation of KNU is aimed at solving the problems of integration into the world and scientific community, strengthening the international image of the university. This work is carried out within the framework of cooperation programs with leading foreign universities, implementation of international educational programs and projects, implementation of joint research activities, organization of seminars and conferences, exchange of teaching staff, development of student mobility.

On the main directions of activity of KNU named after J. Balasagyn today there are more than 200 agreements on cooperation. Currently, international cooperation is developing in various forms. These are international conferences, seminars, summer and winter schools, videoconferences, internships, double degree programs, sandwich programs, teaching and student exchanges, organization of online events.

The University has close ties in educational, scientific and cultural spheres with several dozens of international organizations and institutions, as well as with leading universities from near and far abroad, such as:
