

About the Faculty

The Faculty of State and Municipal Administration is one of the modern and dynamically developing faculties of the KNU named after Zh. Balasagyn, which trains personnel for state and municipal service.

The faculty has a comprehensive system of training graduates, which includes: bachelor's and master's degrees. Training is carried out in the direction 580900 "State and municipal administration"

Entrance tests are the results of ORT.

History of the Faculty of State and Municipal Administration

On May 29, 1996, at the initiative of the rector of KNU Toktomushev S.Zh. and decision

Academic Council of KSNU established the Training Center "Strategic Research public service and political sciences".

The training center began training specialists from state and municipal employees of the highest qualification, as well as in the field of political and social sciences.

Considering the great importance of personnel training for the state and municipal administration, the Training Center was allocated both budgetary and extra-budgetary places, and also permission was given to recruit students of the master's program (in number of 20 people).

At the same time, the management of the center conducted correspondence on the training of specialists

this direction at the regional level, as a result of which a center for training of specialists on the basis of Naryn State University, which lasted until 2003, releasing more than 300 people.

Melikov, some of which continue to work to this day.

By the decision of the Academic Council of KSNU on April 8, 1999 on the basis of the Training Center was

established the Institute of Public Administration and Social Research, thereby training of specialists in this area has been raised to a new level.

The ongoing social and political reforms in the republic required

highly qualified personnel in the management of social processes. Exactly such personnel were called upon to train the Institute of Public Administration and Social

research. One of the first institutes in Kyrgyzstan to start training specialists

civil servants of the highest qualification for the public and

municipal administration, as well as in the field of political and social sciences and

conducting scientific research. The diploma obtained by graduates gave the right

work in rural administrations, in district and regional state administrations,

ministries and departments, in the government apparatus.

In 2001, more than 100 professors and

teaching staff, including 14 doctors and 26 candidates of sciences. In its structure

there was a faculty of philosophy and public service, a center for sociological and

marketing research, editorial board of the journal "Politics and Society", methodological

office and labor exchange.

In 2003, the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic decides on the elimination of duplication in the training of specialists in universities and on their streamlining.

On this wave, the institute, as an independent division of the university, was liquidated and all its functions were transferred to the Faculty of Philosophy and Public management.

Despite the short period of existence, the institute in many respects showed themselves as a viable and necessary subject in the structure of the university. They talk about it

the following data. Institute of Public Administration and Social Research (ISU and SI), in addition to educational and research activities, carried out a great deal of multifaceted work in the field of human rights education and international relations.

Within the framework of the project of the Eurasia Foundation "Improvement of public administration and

civil service in Kyrgyzstan" were translated and published from English into Russian by two

books by G. Wright, seminars were held with the participation of representatives of all ministries

Republic on the problem of reforming public administration. March 2000 year, week-long seminars were organized to improve the skills of heads of aiylokmotu and chief accountants of local governments in 7 regions and the city of Bishkek.

Together with the Congress of Local Communities and the Civil Service Department of the apparatus

Institute of the Prime Minister of the Kyrgyz Republic conducted a 2-year retraining and promotion course

qualifications of public administration and local self-government personnel in specializations: "Civil servant-lawyer", "Civil servant-manager", "Public management and local self-government", "State regulation of the economy".

Within the framework of the TACIS project "Improving public administration in Kyrgyz Republic" in 1998, the staff of the Institute conducted a SWOT analysis activities of ministries and departments of the republic in order to improve their activities.

The international relations of the institute developed extensively. ISU and SI successfully

collaborated with the Department of Political Science of Al-Farabi Kazakh State University, with

Permanent Mission of UNDP in the Kyrgyz Republic on the issue of "Rights Human Rights and Democracy" and with the international fund "Eurasia" to develop a project

"State Administration and Local Self-Government". He also kept in touch with International Institute of Education, Stockholm University (Sweden),

communication was well established with the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Ukrainian

Republic for the exchange of experience and educational literature.

The Department of Public Administration was established in 1996, and the head Ph.D., Associate Professor Alymkulov N.A. was appointed the department, and at that moment at the department

the following teaching staff worked: Akunov A.A., Eginaliyev M.S., Abdrakhmanova Zh.S.,

Ibraeva V.S.

Since 1998-99 head of the department Ph.D. in Economics, Associate Professor Aituganova Zh.Zh.

In April 1999, head of the Department of Public Administration of IGUSI is appointed Doctor of Economics. I.I. Iskakov.

In June of the same year, 5 teachers of the department through the project "Eurasian Fund"

were sent to the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Ukrainian Republic for

improving their qualifications. Studying abroad provided an opportunity for a new way

to comprehend the organization of the educational process, scientific activities of members of the department, in

conditions of developing market relations, the formation of a new system

of state and municipal administration. It was during this period that students

specialties were just beginning to study special disciplines, which required

department staff to introduce new academic disciplines, revise curricula

and programs. This is how the foundations of a new state educational institution began to emerge.

A standard, the full version of which was prepared and submitted to the Ministry

of education by members of the department Akunov A., Iskakov I., Bazakeeva K.

Since 2000, the scientists of the institute have been publishing socio-political and scientific

magazine "Politics and Society". The founders of the journal were ISU and SI and the party

Unity of Kyrgyzstan (PEC).

The Institute consisted of departments: "Public administration and local

self-government", "Political science", "Philosophy", "Sociology", "Psychology",

"Pedagogy of Higher School", "Religious Studies", Center for Sociological and

marketing research, labor exchange, printing house and editorial office of the magazine "Politics and

society".

As a result of the reorganization in 2001, the Institute was transformed into a faculty

philosophy and public administration. Dean of the faculty from 2001 to 2003. was appointed professor Akunov A.A., from 2003 to 2007. - Associate Professor Bazakeyeva K.Zh.

The faculty of the Faculty of Philosophy and Public management (2003)

In September 2007, the faculty was transformed into the Institute of Social humanities with the transfer of the specialty "State and municipal management" and the department "Public administration and local self-government" to

Institute of Management and Business.

Since November 2010, by the decision of the Academic Council of the KNU. J. Balasagyn was created

Institute of Public Administration and Political Science with the assignment to it of the departments of "GU and LSU" and "Political Science".

By the decision of the Academic Council in October 2011, the Institute of State management and political science was transformed into the Faculty of State and municipal government.

At the moment there are two departments at the faculty:

1. Department of state and municipal service;
2. Department of state regulation of the economy.

To date, the faculty of the faculty consists of

out of 20 people, including 1 Doctor of Science, 9 Candidates of Science, 5 Senior Lecturers and 2
